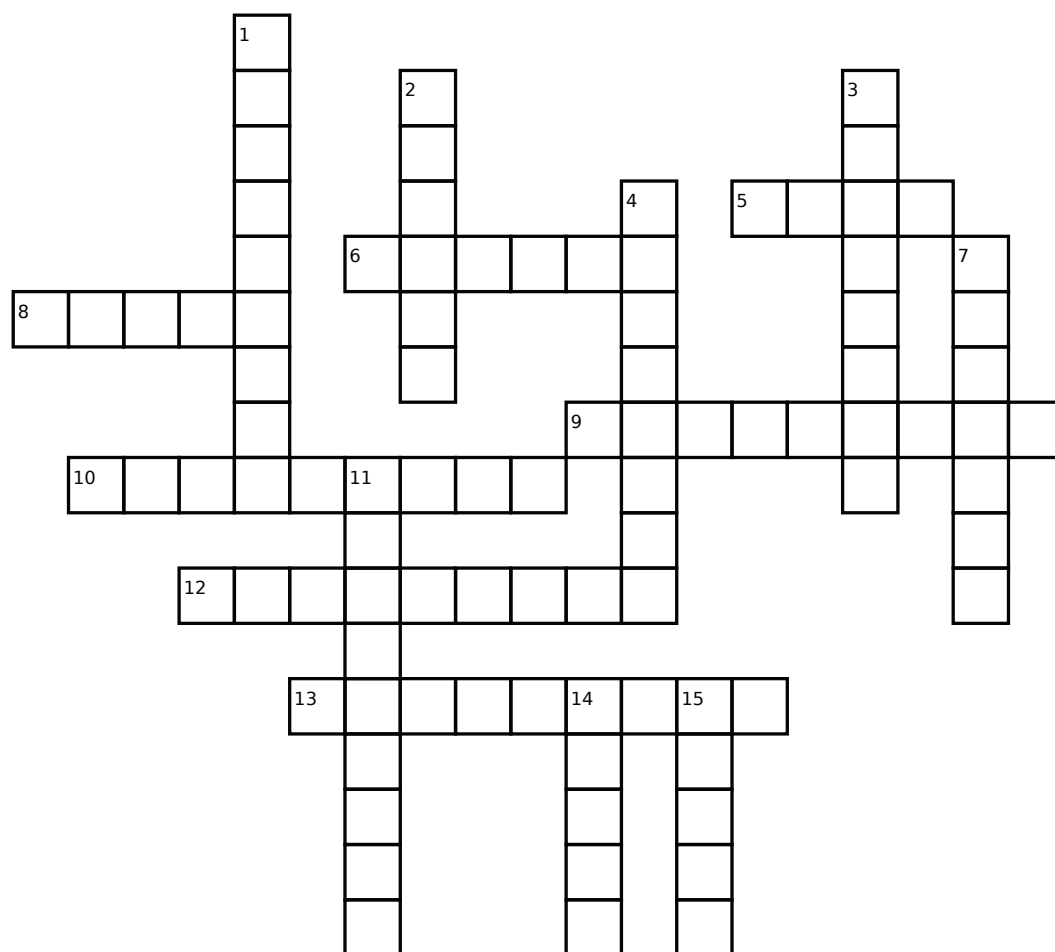

- a river in eastern Africa.
- commune on the Mincio River west-southwest of Venice in northern Italy.
- peninsula in eastern Asia between the Yellow Sea and the East Sea (Sea of Japan) with a strait of the same name to the south and China to the north.
- city and capital of Iowa.
- state in the northern U.S. bordering on Ontario and Manitoba, Canada and on Lake Superior.
- a city and the capital of Scotland.
- a ruined village in eastern Virginia, southwest of Williamsburg on the James River; the first permanent English settlement in America, settled in 1607.

#### Down:

- city in southwest central Germany on the Rhine River.
- a state of southwestern India bordering on the Arabian Sea.
- a landlocked country in western Europe in the Alps — called also Switzerland.
- city in Bavaria, Germany, northeast of Nuremberg.
- a city in central Italy on the Arno River and capital of the region of Tuscany.
